With a geological base in coal, nickel, gold, platinum, emeralds, limestone, salt, gypsum, copper and manganese ores, amongst other discoveries, the government is committed to expanding the sector and welcomes foreign investment. Colombia is the number one producer of emeralds worldwide, and the number one producer of thermal coal in the Latin America. In the past few years, the country has experienced an increase in gold exploration and other base metals. Due to the confidence and business opportunities Colombia offers investors, mining has become a major player in the country's economy.

During the 6th edition of the "Colombian Day Seminar", the Ministry of Mines and Energy and the National Mining Agency will present the sector's achievements during the past year and the government's goals and commitments for the next four years.
